What is Baptism?

Baptism is a simple ceremony of washing in water practiced by Christians since the first century. It is a symbol of turning toward new life, and a sign of trust in the way of Jesus.

The Symbols

In baptism we are reminded that <u>water</u> is necessary for all life and growth. <u>The oil of</u> the chrism is used to anoint the baptised with the sign of the cross which sets signs us as beloved of God, with a call on our lives to live fully in the world. <u>The candle presented at</u> baptism is a symbol of the way of Jesus lights our way, and the calling to be light to each other wherever we go.

Who may be Godparents?

Godparents are baptised people who are likely to remain involved and close to the child and family over the formative years. They are persons to rely on and emulate in their way of life. 2 - 4 persons would be appropriate.

When does baptism take place?

The Anglican church has a preference for the celebration of baptism within the main Sunday service which enables members of the parish family to welcome the baptised and offer their own vow of affirmation and support. However, private baptism may also be possible on some Sunday afternoons at 12pm.

How much does it cost?

There is no charge for baptism, however it is customary to offer a thanksgiving donation to the church.
